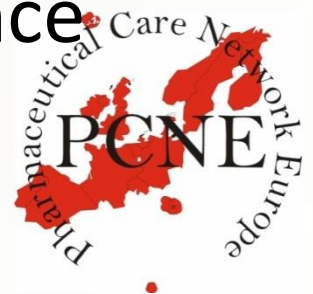

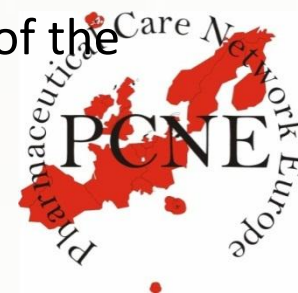

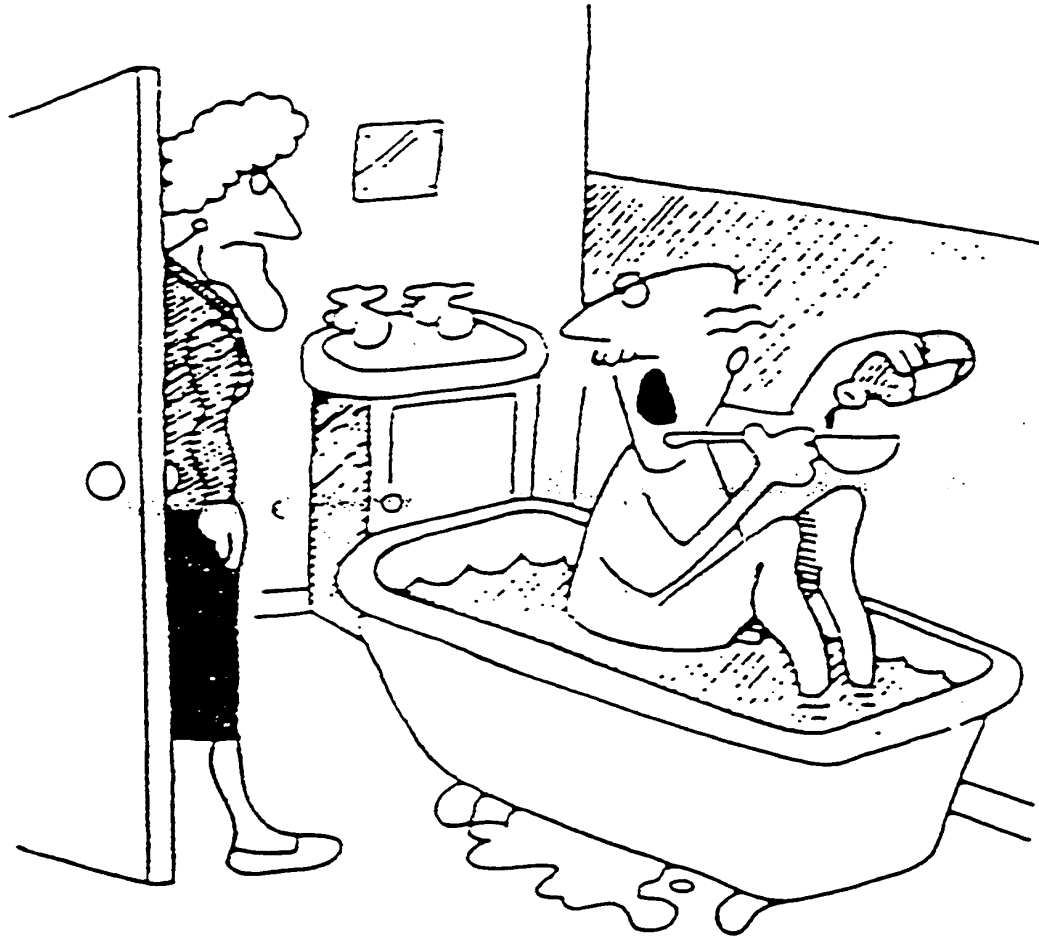

- Second official meeting Dublin 2011: rephrasing definition, and looking at methods

Types of Medication Review (PCNE)

„simple“ Medication Review

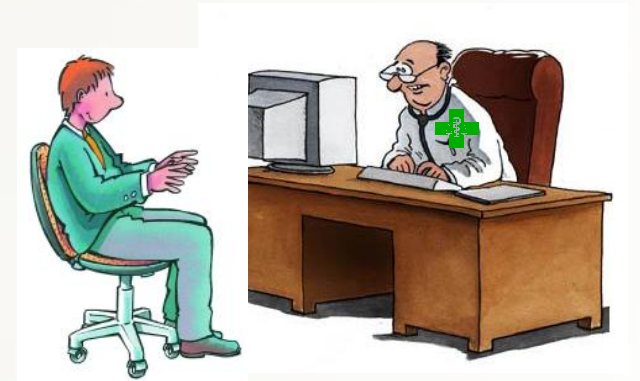
→ based on the medication history in the pharmacy



„intermediate“ Medication Review

→ Based on medication history + patient interview

- MUR, Polymedikations-Check
- „Brown Bag“-Methode



„advanced“ Medication Review

→ medication history + patient interview + clinical data

- Clinical Medication Review



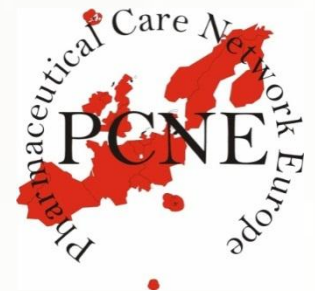
Generic definition

Medication review is an evaluation of a patient's drugs, optimizing the outcome of drug therapy and minimizing the number of drug related problems.



PCNE Working Definition (Dublin 2011)

- Medication review is an evaluation of a patient's medicines with the aim of optimizing the outcomes of medicine therapy. This entails **identifying** the risks, detecting medication-related problems **and suggesting solutions**. Medication review should be part of the management of medication therapy.
