Abstract guideline

The scope of the abstracts

Abstracts must preferably liaise with the themes of the Working Symposium/Conference or the PCNE topics:

- Other research in Pharmaceutical Care
- Drug-related Problems
- Medication Review
- Adherence
- Indicators and Guidelines.

Abstract structure

The maximum length of the abstracts should be at most 400 words (excluding the title and name(s) and institutes/companies of the authors and co-authors).

Required subheadings are:

- Title
- Background
- Purpose (research question)
- Method / study design
- Findings
- Conclusion

The novelty of the abstract

Abstracts that present novel research previously submitted to scientific journals or other conferences are welcome but should be disclosed, and if already accepted, also appropriately referenced. However because of self-plagiarism, such abstracts will not be published in the PCNE Conference Abstract Section of the Journal RSAP (Research in Social and Administrative Pharmacy), and they will not be considered for the best oral or poster presentation prize.

Study design and preliminary work are welcome. In this case, authors should still in their abstract fill in all subheadings, for example, providing methodological reflections or describe expected results under 'Findings'.
