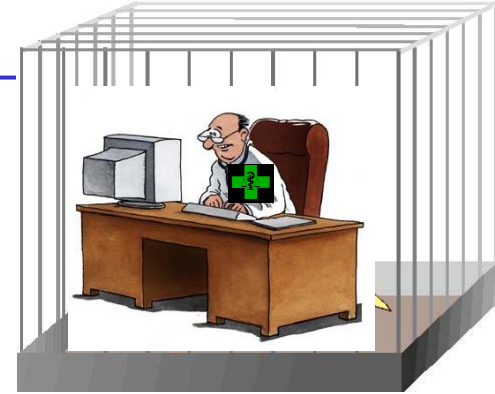
PCNE Definition

Medication review is an evaluation of patient's medicines with the aim of managing the risk and optimizing the outcome of medicine therapy by detecting, solving and preventing drug-related problems. (Manchester 2011)

Types of Medication Review (PCNE)

„simple“ Medication Review

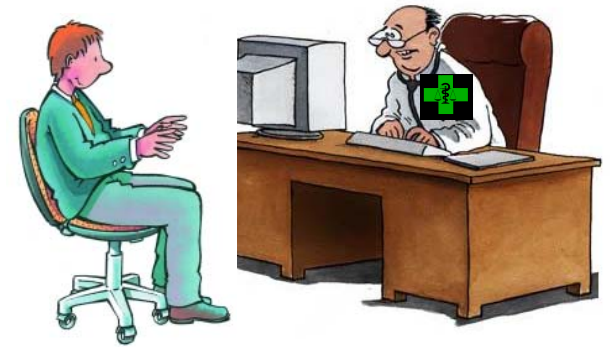
→ based on the medication history in the pharmacy



„intermediate“ Medication Review

→ Based on medication history + patient interview

- MUR, Polymedikations-Check
- „Brown Bag“-Methode



„advanced“ Medication Review

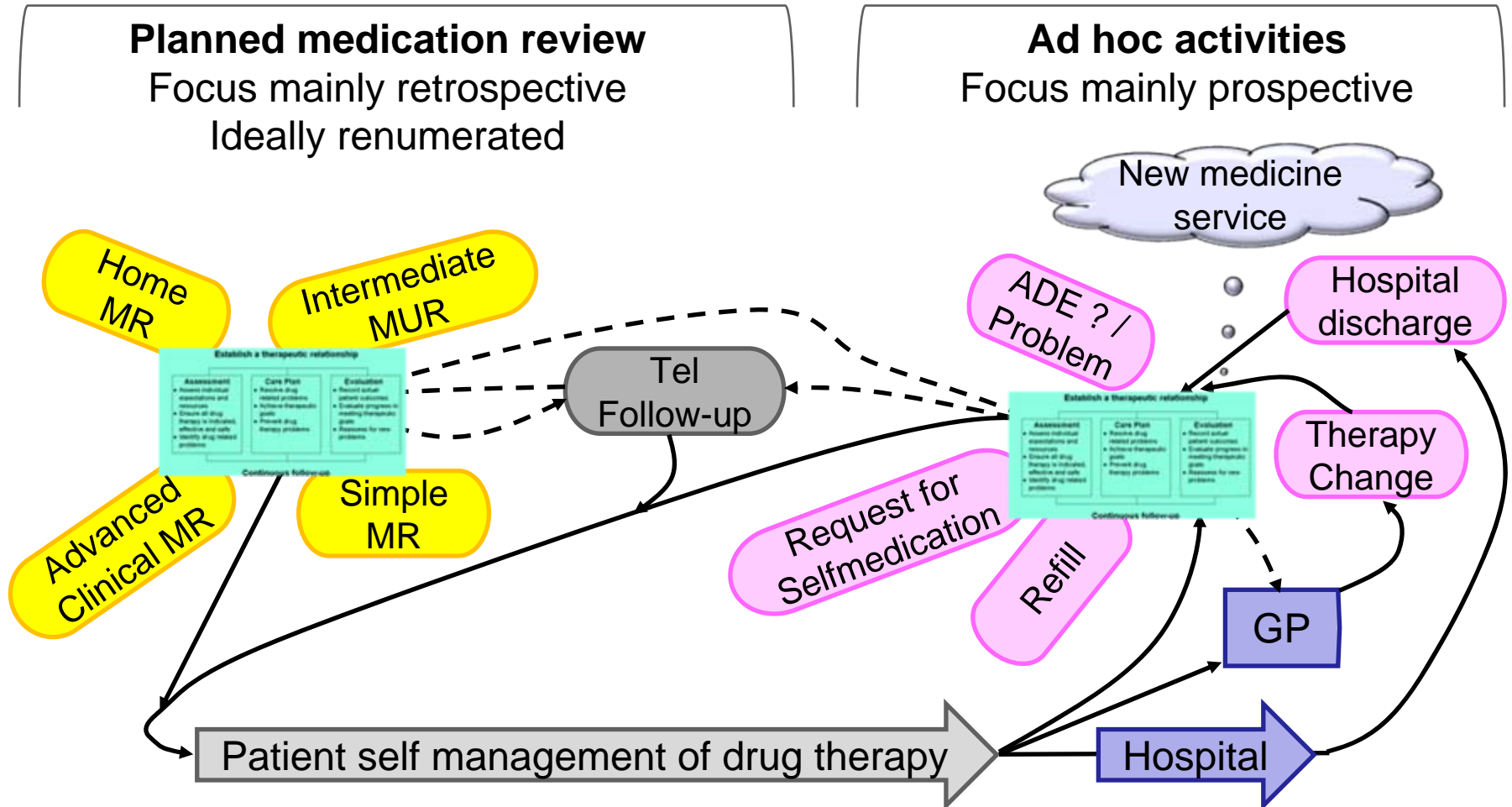
→ medication history + patient interview + clinical data

- Clinical Medication Review
