Workshop 5: Stimulating competences in interdisciplinary collaboration.

- A workshop primarily for people developing and implementing collaborative services and teachers in pharmaceutical care.
- Aim of the workshop: To develop a framework and teaching methodologies, and to prepare practitioners to contribute to interprofessional research and practice, so that different professionals will cooperate better in their future.

The original program of the InterProfessional Collaboration In Health Care (IPCIHC) lasts one week. In three workshops we would like to guide you through an interprofessional learning experience by doing the exercises students have to do to develop their collaborator competence. On the workshop menu you can find an 'interprofessional introduction round', "interprofessional discussion about some theorems", "working out a case" and finally a "self and peer assessment of the competence" will be offered.

During the workshops participants get the opportunity to reflect upon their own competence of collaborator in health care and receive feedback.
